Chapel/Assembly

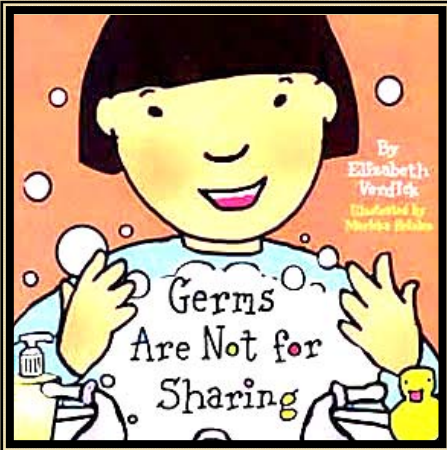
